Aspley Heath Neighbourhood Planning Referendum

- 1. A referendum will be held on Thursday, 23 October 2025 to decide on the question below:
- 2. The question which will be asked in the referendum is;

'Do you want Central Bedfordshire to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Aspley Heath to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'

- 3. The referendum area is Aspley Heath as identified on the map www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/info/45/planning_policy/473/neighbourhood_planning/5
- 4. A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if on Thursday, 23 October 2025
 - He/She is entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area (the deadline for registration is 07/10/2025)
 - His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A
 person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the Register of
 Electors, the address in respect of which he or she entitled to be registered.
- 5. The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2391. The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which the limit has been calculated is 497.
- 6. The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedure which are similar to those used at local government elections.
