Yellow lines on Church Road – The request had been sent to CBC to shorten the lines and CBCllr Baker was chasing this up. CBC were also seriously considering passing places as there were poor lines of sight on Church Road. The road was unable to be adopted by anyone other than the District Council (Nov 2022) Councillors noted that ticketing was now taking place on Church Road by CBC Enforcement Officers. The Parish Council were aware that recently added yellow lines had been put in opposite the Dairy. The Parish Council did not request these and CBC had confirmed that they did not request or install them. CBC would be removing them.

### 2387 To Discuss the Bike Jump Area in Aspley Woods

A Risk Assessment was still being sought. Another ambulance call out had been made to the site. The Bedfordshire Safety Advisory Group (SAG) were to meet with Bedford Estate. Responses from the Neighbourhood Plan were in favour of parking being installed at the old Steetley site. For now, it was hoped that users of the bike jump area would be encouraged to use the Longslade Lane car park to reduce the issues on Church Road. Rubbish around the site had increased again and there were reports that the jumps were being altered by users which was a huge safety concern. It was agreed that a letter of concern be sent to Bedford Estate and Greensand Trust about the lack of toilets, rubbish and safety. (July 2022)

#### 2440c To Discuss the Hedge in Church Road/Narrow Path

PCIIr Smith had received the letters regarding overhanging hedges and would distribute to offending properties. (Nov 2022)

2453d Some residents from Woburn Sands had complained to the Parish Council about lights installed onto a property in Church Road which were causing light pollution. The Parish Council had offered help to residents with filling out online forms on the CBC website regarding light pollution. A resident had also reported a tall, green metal fence had been put up and there were several pieces of heavy machinery in the garden. They were worried this amounted to a change of usage by the property. CBCllr Baker would be asked to check this. (Jan 2023)
